4.  $\rho \frac{D\omega}{Dt} = \nu \nabla^2 \omega$  (vorticity diffusion)

5.  $\frac{D\omega}{Dt} = \omega \cdot \nabla \mathbf{v} - \nabla \omega \cdot \mathbf{v}$  (vorticity advection)

6.  $\frac{D\theta}{Dt} = \theta \cdot \nabla \mathbf{v} - \nabla \theta \cdot \mathbf{v}$  (theta advection)

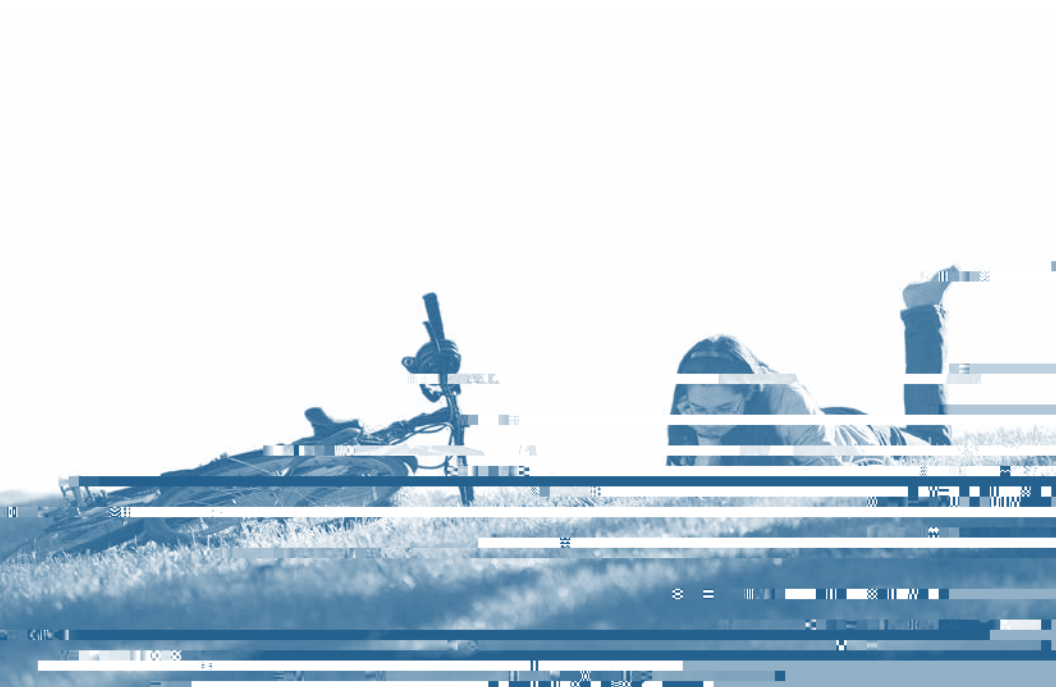
